Chairman Roberts called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

**NEW BUSINESS**

David Heger, County Counselor, requested the Commissioners to consider approving a resolution showing the findings of the fence viewing from August 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. as meeting the standards for a legal partition fence pursuant to Article 1, Chapter 29 of Kansas Statutes. The properties viewed are located in Sugar Creek Township between the properties of Arnold & Mary Jo Weers and Jeffrey B. Weinstein. Chairman Roberts stated the viewing took place with all property owners present. Commissioner Dixon moved to approve the resolution for the findings, Commissioner Pretz seconded. Commissioner Vaughan recused himself, he was not present for the viewing. The vote was 4 approved and 1 abstained. (R20-08-003)
