## What Is Home Visiting?

Home visiting is a free, voluntary program that brings a trained professional to help at convenient times for you and your family.

Home visitors provide education, initiate referrals, and assist mothers and families in accessing community systems of care.

A registered nurse supervisor is also available for any health related questions or concerns.



## MCH Home Visiting Program

This service is available for pregnant women and families with an infant up to one year of age.

Home visits are typically conducted during the prenatal and postpartum periods. The number of visits is based individually on the family's goals and needs assessment.

The MCH Home Visiting Program works to support healthy pregnancies, improve birth outcomes and promote healthy infant development.
