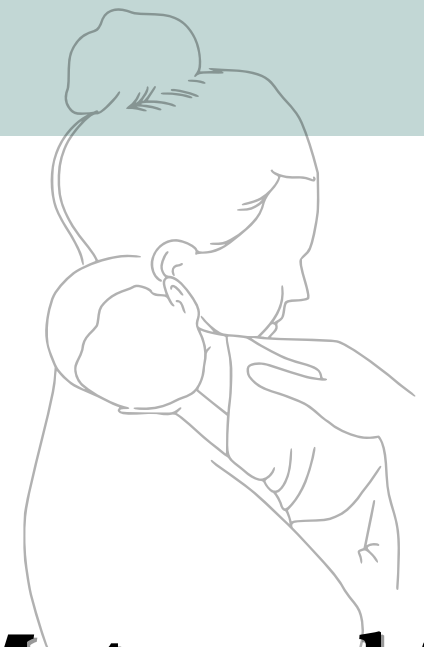

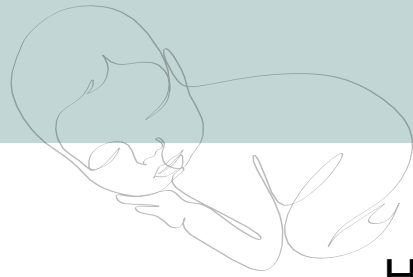

## SAFE SLEEP TRAINING:

A Safe Sleep Instructor, who is certified with the Kansas Infant Death and SIDS Network, offers free, safe sleep training, education and resources.

### WHO SHOULD BE TRAINED?

- Parents / Guardians
- Caregivers
- Child Care Providers
- Health Care & Other Professionals

The Safe Sleep Instructor can provide safe sleep education and resources, a portable crib and a sleep sack to pregnant women or newly delivered women who are in need of a safe sleep environment for their infant.

## HOME VISITING SERVICES:

Home visiting is a free, voluntary program that brings a trained professional to help at convenient times for you and your family. Home visitors provide education, initiate referrals, and assist mothers and families in accessing community systems of care.

A registered nurse is also available for any health-related questions or concerns.



## KAN-BE-HEALTHY SCREENING:

A Kan-Be-Healthy screening is for children, teenagers and young adults. Everyone who is age 21 or younger, and has Kansas Medicaid coverage can take part in the program.

### WHAT SCREENINGS ARE COVERED?

- Vision
- Dental
- Hearing
- Medical

## SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS:

Provides care resource coordination for infants, children, and youth up to age 21 who have eligible medical conditions, and to persons of all ages with specific metabolic or genetic conditions
