Regarding: **State of Kansas Driver's Under 21 Notice**

Driver's Under 21 Notice:

If you turn 21 on this renewal, be aware that you can not go into an office to renew your license until your actual birthday. Effective July 1, 2007 House Bill 2042 grants a 45 day extension on the expiration date of your license for driving purposes. This is to accommodate those who can not come in on their actual birthday. Carry this notice along with your expiring license in case you are questioned by law enforcement. This 45 day expansion only applies to those who are turning 21 with this renewal.

Excerpts from the applicable Kansas Statute (this is not the full text of the law):

8-247. Expiration of licenses; ... notice; renewal of license; ... (a) (1) All original licenses shall expire as follows:

(E) licenses issued to persons who are less than 21 years of age shall expire on the licensee's twenty-first birthday.

(2) Any licensee, whose driver's license expires on their twenty-first birthday, shall have 45 days from the date of expiration of such license to make application to renew such licensee's license. Such license shall continue to be valid for such 45 days or until such license is renewed, whichever occurs sooner.
