<u>Load not covered</u> – Tarped	\$10.00 per load

* *Must be certified freon-free by a licensed technician. Owner must present documentation with appliance at disposal site. Documentation must include: Company name, address and phone number, technician's name and the license (certification) number.*

Definitions/Requirements of refuse not going through the transfer station:

Tarp: All loads must be tarped regardless of what is in the load. If trash is in both truck and trailer, then both must be tarped. Nets are NOT an allowable cover.

Tires: Tires must be put in a separate area.

Freon Appliances: Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners and de-humidifiers will go in a separate area. Certified appliances will be separate from the others.

Scrap Metal and non-freon appliances: Any metal products (i.e barn tin, mowers, etc.) and non-freon appliances (i.e. washers, stoves, etc.) will go in this area.

Yard waste: Trees, brush, leaves and grass. No bags.

Construction – Demolition Waste: Waste resulting from construction, remodeling, repair and demolition of structures. Including, but not limited to: roofing materials, wood, wood products, wall covering, plaster, drywall, small pieces of concrete, brick, rock, soil and asphalt pavement. Waste not included in this category, but not limited to: carpet, cardboard, paper, plastic, can/drums, caulking tubes, etc. No bags.

Transfer Station: Waste not list above will go in this area. This includes, but not limited to: Paper, plastic, cardboard, household trash, furniture, etc. Cleaning out of a garage, basement, house, etc.
