Rounding out the top 20 are Phillips & Associates, SHG Resources, Magellan Pipeline Company, JAJ Real Estate, Southern Star Central Gas Pipe, MOKAN Dial Company, ARC-Kansas, Paola Realty Partners, Landmark National Bank and Southwestern Bell Telephone.

Those top 20 taxpayers represent more than \$60.8 million in assessed valuation or roughly 18% of the county's overall assessed valuation. They also combined to pay more than \$7.6 million in taxes.
