\* Must be Certified Freon-Free by a licensed technician. Owner must present documentation with appliance at Disposal Site. Documentation must include: Company Name, Address and Phone Number, Technician's name and the license (certification) number.

PPE is required while at the Miami Transfer Station. We are no longer loaning this out. You may bring in your own Hard Hat and Safety Vest or you may purchase at the scales.

**Definitions / Requirements of refuse not going through the Transfer Station**

**Tarps:** All loads must be tarped regardless of what is in the load. If trash is in both truck and trailer, then both must be tarped. Nets are NOT an allowable cover.

**Tires:** Whole Tires must be put in a separate area. **If tires are quartered they will be put right in with trash at the Transfer Station.**

**Freon and Non-**

**Freon Appliances:** Refrigerators, Freezers, Air Conditioners, De-Humidifiers, Washers, Dryers, Stoves, and Dishwasher's will go in a separate area around to the south of the Transfer Station. All appliances will be put in the same area.

**Yard Waste:** Trees, brush, leaves and grass clippings. Compost Bags ONLY if any.

**Transfer Station:** Waste not listed above will go in this area. This includes, but not limited to: Paper, Plastic, Cardboard, Household trash, Furniture, C & D, etc. Cleaning out of a Garage, basement, house, etc. **If tires are quartered they will be put right in with trash at the Transfer Station.**
