USD 416 Recreation District

Shall the following be adopted?

Shall the one mill cap for the Louisburg Recreation Commission be removed and the levying of two mills in the tax year 2022, providing support of current and future recreational projects, which may include new sport facilities on Louisburg city-owned property; Thereafter, such increase shall not exceed one mill in each successive budget year and not exceed a total of four mills; pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 12-1927 et seq.? Yes or No

USD 368 Recreation District

Shall the following be adopted?

Should the Paola Unified School District #368 and the City of Paola create a joint Recreation System, with an initial levy of one mill through the school district taxing authority and such levy to only be increased as needed and allowed by state law, to provide for recreational needs of all ages, allow for a separate means by which to oversee recreational activities, and fund a number of current and future recreational functions within the Paola Unified School District 368 and the City of Paola, pursuant to the provisions of KSA 12-1922 et seq.? Osawatomie City Sales Tax

Shall the following be adopted?

"Shall the City of Osawatomie levy a special purpose retailers' sales tax in the amount of one-half of one percent (0.5%) to take effect on January 1, 2022 and to be levied for ten years until December 31, 2031, on retail sales consummated within the city of Osawatomie; the proceeds of which shall be used to pay for, in whole or in part with any other funds the cost of repairing, rebuilding, rehabilitating, upgrading and improving streets, sidewalks and all related street infrastructure and any short- or long-term financing required?"
