## **Economic Data Point**

## **County's Largest Taxpayers**

Most businesses and residents keep a close eye on their tax bill. The top 20 taxpayers in Miami County represent more than \$69.5 million in assessed valuation – an increase from \$64.3 million in 2017. They also combined to pay more than \$8.8 million in taxes.

The data detailed below reflects the top 10 owners of property based on assessed valuation. Taxes shown include combined bills encompassing real property, state assessed utilities, personal property, minerals, oil property, gas property, vehicles and watercrafts. Because tax rates vary by classifications, a higher assessed valuation may not necessarily equate to an overall higher tax bill. All numbers are rounded to the closest \$100.
