A Small Change Can Make A **Big Difference!**

When you shift \$20 of your weekly spending to a local business it generates \$1.90 in sales tax. But did you know that sales tax revenue is split between the state, the county, and the city? The city keeps just 30¢ and uses it to pay for things like general city operations, and construction and operation of the aquatic center. Just 30¢.
