The Miami County Comprehensive Plan Public Survey, was available to all county residents. The survey is a guide for the county's future growth and development.

1,124 residents responded to the survey.

Question: I am interested in Miami County because I want to live in the country.

That was the response of 93.96% or 1058 of the people that participated.

Question: Chose the top three reasons you live in Miami County
The number one answer was rural atmosphere. 71% chose that answer.
The remaining 29% was spread out over 8 choices.

Question: Which of the following is most important to you when deciding where development should occur in Miami County. 42.68% voted to preserve the rural character of the county.

Question: Should new development be prioritized in locations where road and utility **infrastructure** is near or already exists? 83% answered yes.

40% of the survey participants live in Northwest Miami County.

I think that this is a mandate and that it is the responsibility of the County Commissioners to listen to the **people and not allow the Edgerton/NorthPoint cabal to move into Miami County and do just the opposite of what the citizens have overwhelmingly told you what they want.**
